Thank you very much for your email. We acknowledged and received notification letter <u>RE: Equine Anti-Doping Rule Violation. Case: 2014/bs09-Bingo S.</u>

Following the notification dated February 16, 2015 relating to the positive test for Bingo S. horse's testosterone, I would before any response on the background of this case and the circumstances of this positive test, say extremely urgently that the rider Maxime Livio is completely independent of this situation. He has been invited to our competition for a public relationship operation.

It is our Federation, which has supplied the horse to Maxime Livio for the jumping sessions.

Maxime Livio had no relationship with the horse, nor before or during the jumping sessions. So he is totally foreign to the causes of this positive test.
